INTRODUCTION

Walter Feret deposited the Chicago and North Western Historical Society Collection in the Northern Illinois Regional History Center on March 24, 1979. Additional records were added to the collection at a later date.

Property rights in the collection are held by the Chicago and Northwestern Historical Society; the literary rights are dedicated to the public. There are no restrictions on access to the collection.

SCOPE AND CONTENT

The Chicago and North Western Historical Society collection partially documents the activities of the Chicago and North Western Railroad from 1836 to the present. It consists of nine series: public relations department files; property records; memorabilia; Chicago and North Western printed material; related publications; the Chicago and North Western Historical Society's publications, North Western Lines; photographs; architectural drawings and maps; and H. Roger Grant's book research. The bulk of the material covers the years 1935 to 1950.

Series one, the Public Relations Department records document the wide range of the company's activities and interests from 1912 to 1969. The railroad industry's role in World Wars I and II are reflected throughout the series. General office files include correspondence, news releases, and equipment and operating data. Also found in this series is historical material used for publications, lectures, and radio programs. Of special interest are the records of the firm's centennial celebration in 1948 including information pertaining to planning and promotion, movies, songs, souvenirs, replicas of the "Pioneer" and "400", and the book Pioneer Railroad. With the exception of 1943 and 1944 the Chicago and Northwestern Railroad's annual reports are missing.

Property records are found in series two. One unidentified bound volume contains information on Wisconsin and Michigan lumber companies from 1929 to 1942. Eight bound volumes of physical property records contain information on the M.L.S. & W. Railway branches in 1892 and indicate the mile posts on each branch line.

Memorabilia accumulated primarily for use in the railroad's 1948 centennial celebration are found in the third series. A copy of the original incorporation papers of the Galena and Chicago Union Railroad (1836) have been retained. Also to be found are tickets, permits, passes, and complimentary souvenirs, representing the years 1854 to 1933. Original manuscript material includes general correspondence, company forms, and notices. Arranged alphabetically by item,

much of this material provided a visual display for the firm's centennial train (1948) and the Chicago Railroad Fair (1948, 1949).

Series four consists of material printed by the Chicago and North Western Railroad from 1850 to 1977. Included are announcements, invitations, travel brochures, and information pertaining to agriculture, land grants, natural resources, industrial opportunities, and railroad facilities. Also found are lists of officers, agents and stations, time tables, and material relating to the freight and passenger department. The railroad's official publication, North Western has gaps in the early issues but a complete run is found from September 1917 to May 1925. A few issues of "Timely Topics" for the years 1940-45 are included and the North Westerner Newsliner has been retained from November 1945 to October 1953 with January to August 1952 missing. Of special interest are two volumes of editorials concerning the 1962 strike of the Order of Railroad Telegraphers against the Chicago and North Western Railroad.

Related printed material includes information pertaining to other railroads and various on-line cities and states. The bulk of series five consists of the Official Guide of the Railways with one issue of the monthly publication represented, with the exception of 1965, from 1940 to 1976.

The sixth series finds North Western Lines, the official publication of the Chicago and North Western Historical Society. First printed in 1977 future issues of this quarterly will be added.

Additional records were added at a later date. These addenda are listed after series six. The photographs and negatives were pulled from the manuscript folders and added to the end of the collection inventory as series seven. The titles of the photograph envelopes remain the same as the manuscript folders. This enables the researcher to locate the prints pulled from the folders.

Architectural drawings and maps of engine, freight, storage house, and depots in Illinois, Iowa, Michigan, Minnesota, and Wisconsin make up the eighth series. Arranged alphabetically by city the drawings date from 1874 to 1945.

The ninth series, H. Roger Grant's Book Research, includes Grant's research for the books he wrote on various railroads.

The researcher should be aware that the W.W. Embree and Finch Marshall Railway Collections contain much valuable related material including books, periodicals, and photographs. Also Pioneer Railroad: The Story of the Chicago and North Western System by Robert J. Casey and W.A.A. Douglas (New York: McGraw-Hill Book Co., Inc., 1948) may be useful.

HISTORICAL SKETCH

The Chicago and North Western Historical Society was founded in 1973 as the Chicago and North Western Historical, Technical and Modeling Society. A not-for-profit corporation,

chartered in the State of Illinois, the group has over 600 members. Governed by a Board of Directors, the society rotates its annual meeting each May to a different site throughout the Midwest and publishes North Western Lines quarterly. The Northern Illinois Regional History Center has been designated as the repository of the society's historical and technical material relating to the Chicago and North Western Railroad.

Organized on June 6, 1859, the Chicago and North Western Railroad first legally used its title in 1861. The parent of the organization, the Galena and Chicago Union Railroad, incorporated in 1836, was the first railroad west of Chicago, reaching the Mississippi River in 1855. Consolidating with the Chicago and North Western Railroad on June 2, 1864, the firm grew through constructions, purchase and merger to service nine Midwestern states.

In 1869, the company assisted in the completion of the first transcontinental railroad, carrying materials to Council Bluffs, Iowa for delivery to the Union Pacific Railroad. Cooperating with this line and the Southern Pacific, an overland route was created, providing connections with the east and the Chicago North Western Railroad with the first train from Chicago to the Pacific Coast. The company has an extensive list of firsts in the industry including: providing the first sleeping cars west of Chicago (1858); introducing cupolas on railroad cabooses (1863); manufacturing railroad postal cars (1865) and putting them into service (1867); using steel rails (1865); operating the first dining car west of Chicago (1869); introducing the Pullman Hotel Car (1877); providing the first regular Pullman train service (1895); and pioneering a railroad safety program (1910). Also, in 1926, they built the world's largest freight yard "Proviso Yard," housing the largest locomotive roundhouse in the United States.

Falling under government control, the firm was regulated by the United States Railroad Administration from December 1917 to March 1920. Due to a business recession from 1920-22, a program of reconstruction was begun in 1923 and completed in 1929. The depression, causing rail earnings to recede rapidly, beginning in 1931, saw sources of private capital almost disappearing by 1933-34 and the company filing bankruptcy on June 28, 1935. Operating under the supervision of the courts, the Interstate Commerce Commission approved reorganization of the Chicago and North Western Railroad Company in 1939. It was returned to private management in 1943 and has been employee owned since 1971.
